



POLICY OF ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGING SYSTEM

1. Foreword

Since 1997 Studio Frosio has adopted a Quality Managing System, according to UNI-EN-ISO 9001 rules, which, besides defining the work done, keeps monitoring all activities falling within the competence of the Studio.

In June 2004 the Studio Frosio Managing Direction decided to take steps to get the certification for the Environmental Managing System of Studio Frosio itself, according to UNI-EN-ISO 14001 rules, in order to further implement the current quality process applying its own Quality System to the environment in which it works and to the products and services it provides.

This report, written following the principles of the above mentioned rules, aims at pointing out and letting the executives of Studio Frosio know the reasons for choosing to apply at Studio Frosio the UNI-EN-ISO 14001 rules.

2. Reasons for choosing to apply UNI-EN-ISO 14001 rules.

The Managing Direction has decided to apply UNI-EN-ISO 14001 rules after a close study of the operating reality of Studio Frosio and after years of experience in applying UNI-EN-ISO 14001 rules.

It actually thinks that conforming to the UNI-EN-ISO 14001 rules makes the activity of Studio Frosio more competitive, acknowledging that the permanent improvement of its own environmental activities leads to remarkable commercial and economical advantages, meeting, at the same time, the expectations of environmental improvement concerning the area in which the company works.

Studio Frosio commits itself to follow a policy of permanent improvement of its own environmental activities, reducing any negative environmental impact of its activities, products or services as much as possible, provided that this could be technically possible and economically feasible.

Conforming to UNI-EN-ISO 14001 rules, Studio Frosio aims at to qualifying its producing process as environmentally sustainable so much so that the products and services offered should be qualified as to be of low environmental impact.

Studio Frosio is aware that in order to attain an environmentally sustainable producing process it cannot disregard its work, therefore it commits itself to apply the Environmental Managing System to the working environment in which it carries out its activities too.

The Managing Direction aims at achieving its goals through the following actions concerning its specific activity and planned processes:

- Make sure that the activities are carried out in conformity with the current regulations and to the existing endorsed codes of practice.

- Carry out and keep following an effective Environmental Managing System according to the requirements of UNI-EN-ISO 14001 rules.
- Make any organizing, operating, and technological effort to avoid pollution.
- Reduce the use of energy, water, materials and the production of waste as much as possible, favouring their recycling where possible.
- Avoid situations that can cause environmental damages, such as landslides, oil leaking, interruption of production, pollution of any kind.
- Define environmental objectives and goals.
- Make sure that the environmental policy above described and the related managing system are understood, carried out, and kept on at any level of the organization and that the system is supported by recurrent and systematic training activities.
